## Privacy, Trademark, and Infringement Policy

The Privacy, Trademark, and Infringement Policy describes how your personal information is collected, used, and shared when you visit taikocommunityalliance.org and our affiliate site, taikosource.org (the “Site”).

### 1. Personal Information We Collect

- a. When you visit the Site, we collect pieces of information about your device, including information about your web browser, IP address, time zone, and certain cookies that are installed on your device. Additionally, as you browse the Site, information is collected about the individual web pages viewed, the websites or search terms that referred you to the Site, and information on how you interact with the Site. We refer to this automatically-collected information as “Device Information.”
- b. We collect Personal Information using the following technologies:
  - i. “Cookies” - data files that are placed on your device or computer and often include an anonymous unique identifier.

  - ii. “Log files” - track actions occurring on the Site, and collect data including your IP address, browser type, Internet service provider, referring/exit pages, and date/time stamps.
  - iii. “Web beacons,” “tags,” and “pixels” - electronic files used to record information about how you browse the Site.
  - iv. “Personal Information” in this Privacy Policy, is about your Device Information
- c. HOW DO WE USE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?: Device Information that we collect helps us screen for potential risk and fraud (in particular, your IP address), and improve and optimize our Site (for example, by generating analytics about how our visitors browse and interact with the Site, and assess the success of our advertising campaigns).



- d. SHARING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION: We share your Personal Information with third parties to help us use your Personal Information as described in Section C above. For example, Google Analytics is utilized to help us understand how our visitors use the Site.

- e. PUBLIC RECORDS REQUEST: TCA reserves the right to share your Personal Information to comply with applicable laws and regulations, to respond to a subpoena, search warrant or other lawful request for information we receive, or to otherwise protect our rights.
- f. DO NOT TRACK: We do not alter our Site's data collection and use practices when we see a Do Not Track signal from your browser.
- g. YOUR RIGHTS: For European residents, you have the right to access personal information we hold about you and ask that your personal information be corrected, updated, or deleted. If you would like to exercise this right, please contact us. Additionally, if you are a European resident, your information will be transferred outside of Europe, including to Canada and the United States where this Site operates from.
- h. CHANGES: We may update this privacy policy from time to time in order to reflect changes to our practices operational, legal or regulatory reasons.
- i. CONTACT US: For more information about our privacy practices, if you have questions, or if you would like to file a complaint, please contact us using the Contact Us form on this Site.

## 3. TCA Copyright Complaint Policy

### a. Infringement Notification

- i. If you believe in good faith that material hosted by us infringe on your copyright and you wish to request we remove the material, please provide the written information requested below. The following procedure is

exclusively for notifying TCA that your copyrighted material has been infringed. Please provide the following information in the provided format (including Section Numbers):

1. A clear identification of the original copyrighted work you claim was infringed.
  2. A clear identification of the material you claim is infringing the copyrighted work, and information that will allow us to locate that material on the Site such as a link to the infringing material
  3. Your contact information, so we can reply to your complaint, preferably including an email address and telephone number.
  4. Please include the following statement: "I have a good faith belief that the material that is claimed as copyright infringement is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law."
  5. Include the following statement: "I swear, under penalty of perjury, that the information in the notification is accurate and I am the copyright owner, or am authorized to act on behalf of the copyright owner, of material that is allegedly infringed."
  6. The notice must be signed by the copyright owner or a person authorized to act on behalf of the copyright owner of material that is allegedly infringed.
- ii. Notices of claims of copyright infringement on this website should be emailed or mailed to:

  - iii. We suggest that you consult your legal advisor before filing a notice. Please note that you may be liable for damages (including costs and attorneys fees) if you make a false claim of copyright infringement. We will review and address all notices that comply with the requirements above.

## b. Repeat Infringer Policy

- i. In accordance with the Digital Millennium Copyright Act ("DMCA") and other applicable law, Taiko Community Alliance (TCA) has adopted a policy of terminating, in appropriate circumstances and at TCA's sole discretion, subscribers or account holders who are deemed to be repeat infringers. TCA may also at its sole discretion, limit access to the Site and/or terminate the accounts of any users who infringe any intellectual property rights of others, whether or not there is any repeat infringement.
